SUPER 21

SUPER 21 is a game similar to blackjack, where the object is to get as close to 21 without going over. The major difference is that the highest card drawn in this game is a 9 and no splits can be played.

KENO DRAWING

After typing RUN, you will be asked to enter a number between 1 and 21 for a modified KENO drawing which will be held approximately every 5 rounds. The number drawn will correspond to your total sum of the round preceeding the drawing, so select a number that you feel will be your sum most often. A \$5000 bonus is added to your cash for winning KENO.

THE PLAY

The first card drawn will be the show card for the house and will be placed in the MY SUM line on the score card. The next 2 cards will be dealt to you and their values will be added for you and placed in YOUR SUM line on the score card. You will be asked if you want another card. If you do, it will be added to your sum line. Each time you desire another card-depress '1' followed by a return. When you feel that your sum is close enough to 21 without taking the chance of going over, just depress the RETURN key. The house will then begin drawing cards and adding them to the sum line. The house is obligated to draw a card when its total is below 18.

THE WIN

If your total is over 17 and it ties with the house total, you win the round!

If your total is greater than 18 but lower than 21 and the house total is greater than 18 but lower than yours, you win! (The house sum will always be higher than 17).

If you reach 21 exactly, you win and the house doesn't draw.

If the house goes over 21, and you are anywhere under 21, you win!

THE LOSS

You will lose the round if you draw enough cards to put your sum over 21.

You will lose if the house total is less than 22 but greater than your sum.

You have 4 ways to win and 2 ways to lose!

THE BET

Prior to each round, you will be asked to bet a portion of your cash on the upcoming round. Maximum bet is \$2000, Minimum bet is \$300. If you win, the

wagered amount is added to your CASH line on the score card and, if you lose, it is deducted.

You may bet all or any portion of your cash and your bet will be displayed on the score card.

You may not bet more than the amount of cash that you have, without obtaining a loan.

THE LOAN

The house is very eager to help out its gamblers, and makes 'Interest Free' loans available when needed.

One stipulation is that you must pay back ALL or ANY PORTION of the loan within 3 rounds, or the house will terminate the game, and it will COST YOU DEARLY. A bonus is given to those who pay their loans in full.

To obtain a loan, enter in a bet which is HIGHER than your cash amount. Minimum loan is \$1000, Max is \$3000. If you have a loan balance, you will not be able to invest any money. The loan must be paid first!!!

INVESTMENTS

If your loan balance is ZERO and your CASH is \$3000 or more (after the first round), you will be asked if you want to invest some money. Any portion of your CASH can be invested at this time. Once you have entered an amount, it will be deducted from your CASH and transferred to the STOCK line on the score card. The house will then sink your money into the market of its choice! Sometimes the market is good, and other times it can be terrible! If good, any earnings will be added to your CASH LINE. If bad, it will be deducted. Remember in any event, the amount that you enter to invest will be deducted from your CASH line. The STOCK amount will be added to your final score and the final score will indicate your total worth (CASH+STOCK-DEBTS) so, as you can see, the more stock that you purchase, either good or bad, the higher your final score!!

FINAL SCORE

Depending upon the GRAND TOTAL, you may be acknowledged as a GOOD GAMBLER by your peers. In any event, you must take your winnings or losses home with you.

After each game, you will be given the opportunity to drive home down a crowded freeway, against the flow of traffic. If you make it, your final score will be higher.
